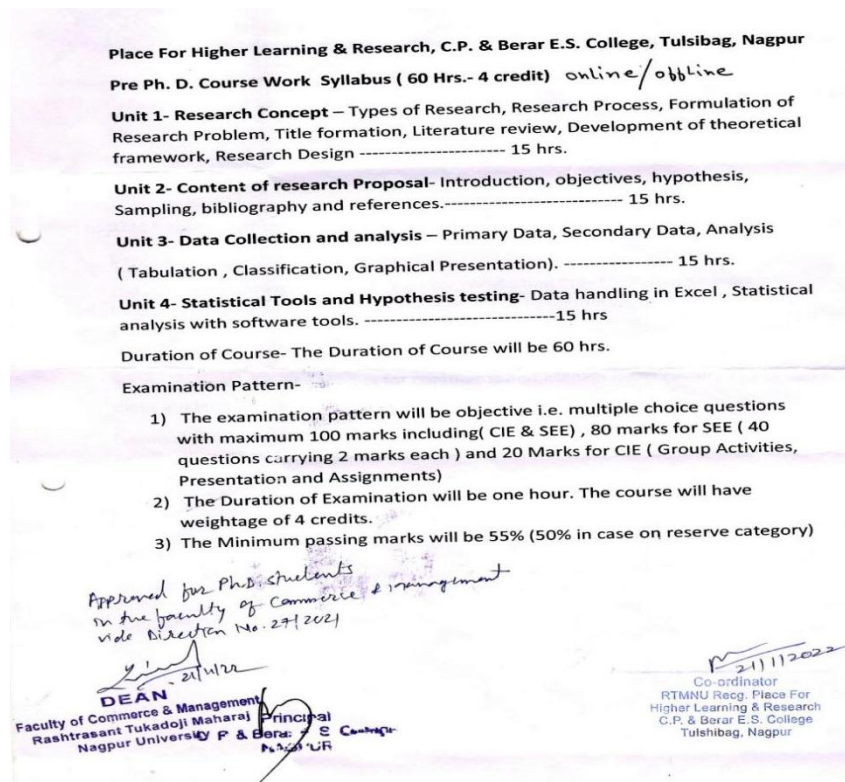

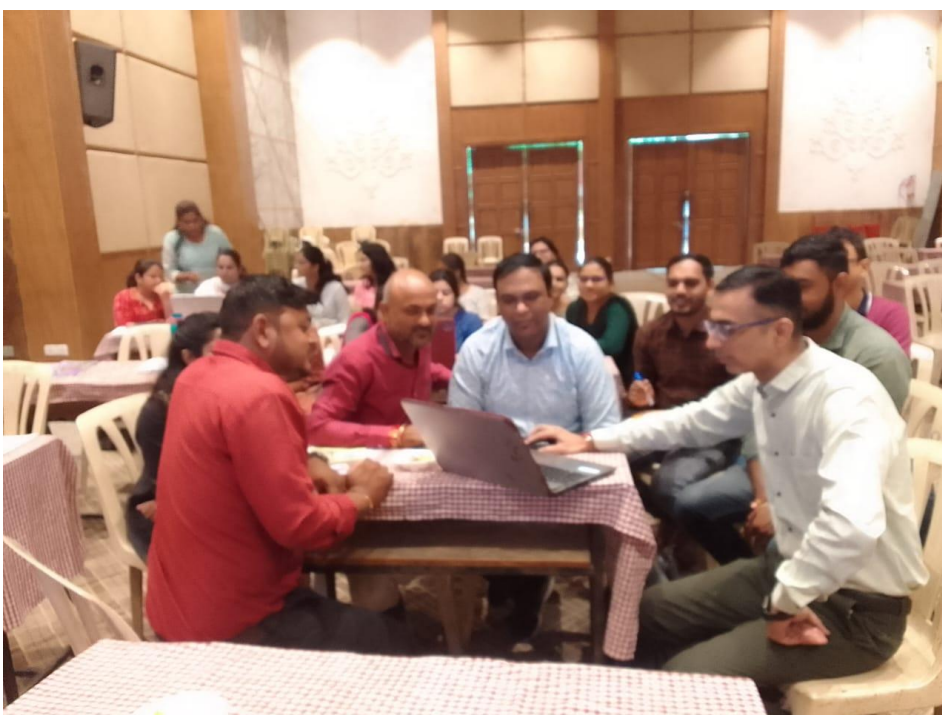



Participants on Doubts getting cleared

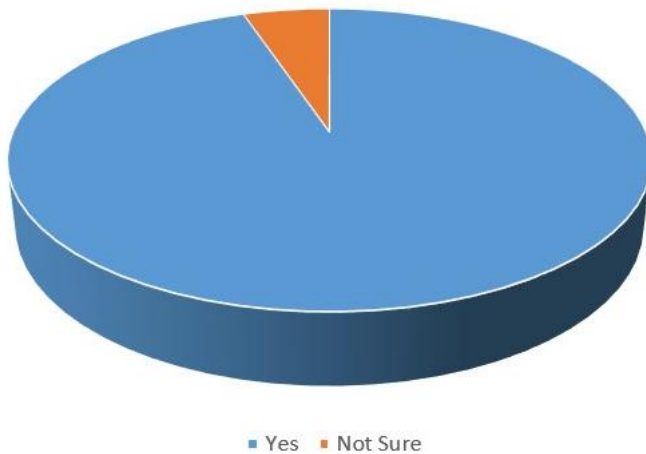

Participants on rating faculty

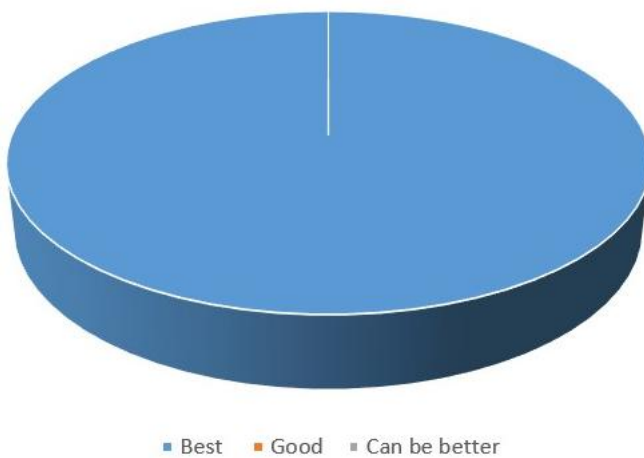
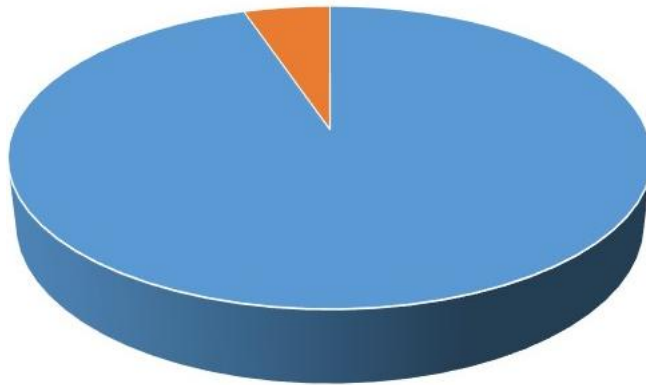
