Brief Report

Anti Ragging Awareness

A program on Anti Ragging Awareness organized by the anti ragging committee. The program was conducted for all the B. Com & B.A. students from 12th -14th August 2025 at 9:30 am. Anti Ragging Awareness was organized under the guidance of Dr. Ajay Kulkarni, Principal, C.P & Berar College & Dr. Jitendra Mahajan, Vice-Principal. The program was planned by Dr. Shikha Jain, Head, Anti ragging committee. Total 103 students attended the program.

On 12th August 2025 at the inaugural program anti ragging committee members Dr. Mrunmayee Kanetkar, Mrs. Malvika Kshirsagar, Miss Naina Wankhede & Mr. Chetan Sawarkar covered the topics like What is ragging, forms of ragging, case studies, negative effects of ragging, laws to prevent ragging, preventive measures through power point presentation. Objective of this program is to foster an environment free from physical, psychological, or emotional abuse especially toward freshers and ensure every student's dignity is respected. Educate students on the harmful effects of ragging, including its legal consequences and mental health impact. Encourage mutual respect, empathy, and healthy interactions between seniors and juniors, steering away from

hierarchical or abusive dynamics. Provide students with accessible, confidential, and trusted channels such as helplines, complaint boxes, and mentorship for reporting ragging and seeking support. Total 42 students were present in the program. Total 38 students were present.

On 13th August 2025, Poster making competition was conducted in room no. A3, in this competition students not only participated alone but they have prepared groups. This competition judges were Dr. Rita Sontakay & Dr. Jaya Golatkar Students prepared posters on the anti ragging theme. Aspiration of this program is visual media like posters can stir empathy and create a lasting impression about the consequences of ragging. Encourages students to think critically and creatively about campus culture and their role in shaping it. When students design awareness messages themselves, it often resonates more strongly with their peers than top-down messaging. Highlights the importance of respect, dignity, and unity across all levels of the academic community. Total 39 students were present.

On 14th August 2025, Skit competition was organized, where students participated in groups and present there skit with proper message for the students. This competition judges were Dr. C.H. Dixit & Dr. Arvind Sovani. Purpose of this program is writing and performing skits encourages participants to reflect on societal issues, develop empathy, and brainstorm positive alternatives to ragging. The UGC has also taken several proactive steps, including the effective launch of media campaigns and awareness activities for preventing ragging. Videos on anti-ragging are also uploaded on UGC website for use by higher education institutions.

As a step further, UGC has decided in 2023 that Anti Ragging Day would be observed on 12th August, followed by Anti Ragging Week from 12th August to 18th August. - iii. Social media campaigns, activity posts, and video messages by the head of the institutions to disseminate Anti-Ragging messages on the institution's website and social media platforms.
- iv. Awareness activities like workshops, seminars, interactive sessions, and other creative avenues such as setting up selfie corners on campus to spread the key messages.
- v. Encourage your students to participate in the National Contest 2025 on Digital Posters, Reels, and Short Videos. Detailed information regarding the National Contest, its categories, deadlines, eligibility, selection, and awards is available at www.anti-ragging.in.
- vi. Anti-Ragging short films (UGC) may be screened for students and faculty (available on UGC website www.anti-ragging.in).
- vii. Forward this advisory to all the colleges within your jurisdiction to celebrate Anti-Ragging Day/Week.




