Organized By: Department of Economics, C.P. & Berar E.S. College, Nagpur.

Introduction

Every year, September 16th is globally observed as World Ozone Day (International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer) to commemorate the signing of the Montreal Protocol. To mark this significant occasion and instill environmental consciousness among young minds, the Department of Economics organized a state-level Online Students' Seminar on September 17, 2025.

The primary objective of this seminar was to raise awareness about the critical issue of ozone layer depletion, explore its socio-economic impacts, and discuss the urgent global and local measures required for environmental preservation and sustainable development.

Inaugural Session

The seminar commenced with a welcome address by vice principal Dr. J.K. Mahajan introducing the significance of World Ozone Day. The introductory remarks emphasized how environmental degradation directly impacts global economic systems and human well-being, highlighting the intersecting relevance of Environmental Economics.

Keynote Address by Resource Person:

Dr. Mahendra Wardhalwar delivered an insightful and thought-provoking keynote speech. He explained the scientific and environmental importance of the stratospheric ozone layer in shielding the Earth from harmful ultraviolet (UV) radiation. He shed light on the economic consequences of climate change, emphasizing how depletion affects agricultural productivity, marine ecosystems, and public health costs. Dr. Wardhalwar encouraged the student community to adopt sustainable lifestyles, minimize carbon footprints, and advocate for green policies to support global Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Student Presentations (The Core Technical Session) :

The highlight of the seminar was the active participation of the students. A total of 12 students presented well-researched papers and PowerPoint presentations. The presentations covered a diverse range of sub-themes, including:

- The Montreal Protocol and its economic implications for developing nations.
- The role of renewable energy in reducing Ozone-Depleting Substances (ODS).
- Consumer behavior and the transition toward eco-friendly, green electronics.
- The direct link between global warming, industrialization, and ozone depletion.

The presentations demonstrated excellent analytical skills, reflecting the students' deep understanding of environmental economics and policy.

Key Takeaways & Discussion

The presentations were followed by a vibrant interactive Q&A session. Students actively engaged with Dr. Wardhalwar, discussing practical solutions such as:

- Phasing out hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs) in domestic cooling appliances.
- Strengthening local rural and urban environmental policies.
- The role of behavioral changes in consumer choices to drive sustainable production.

Conclusion & Vote of Thanks:

At the conclusion of the seminar, the President of the seminar, Principal Dr. Ajay Kulkarni, addressed the students, commending the Department of Economics for organizing a timely and socially relevant event.

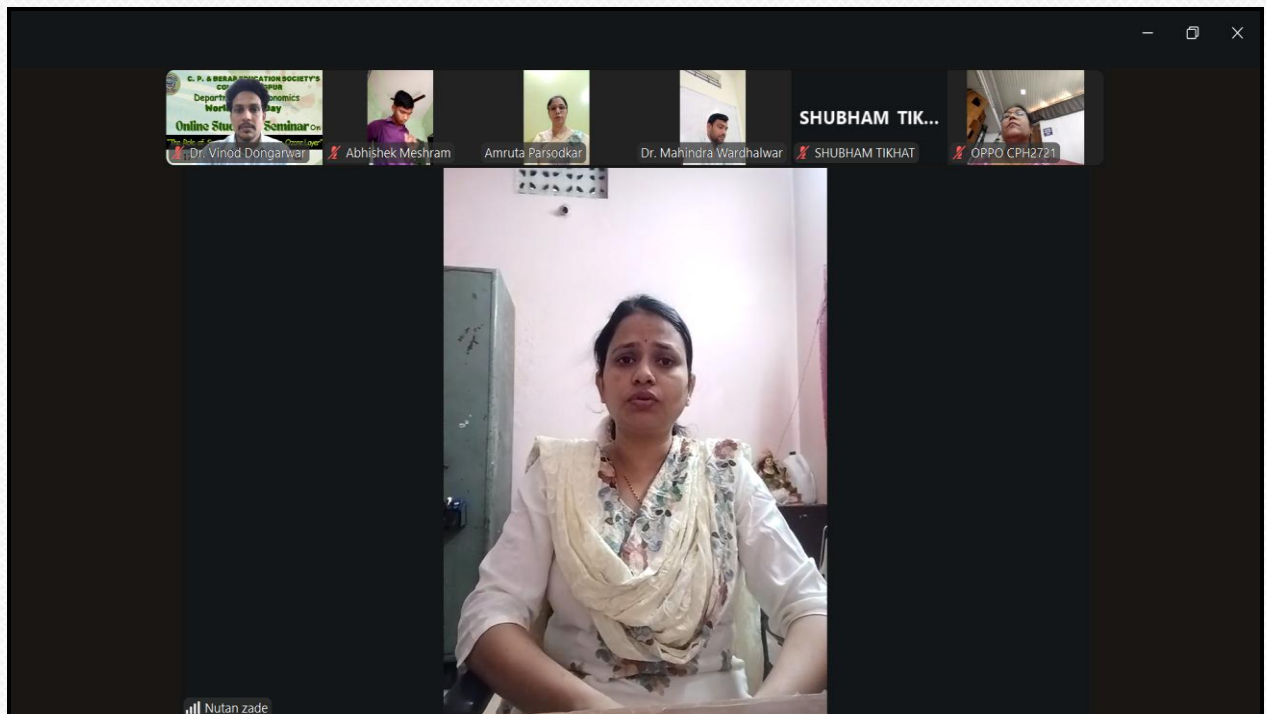

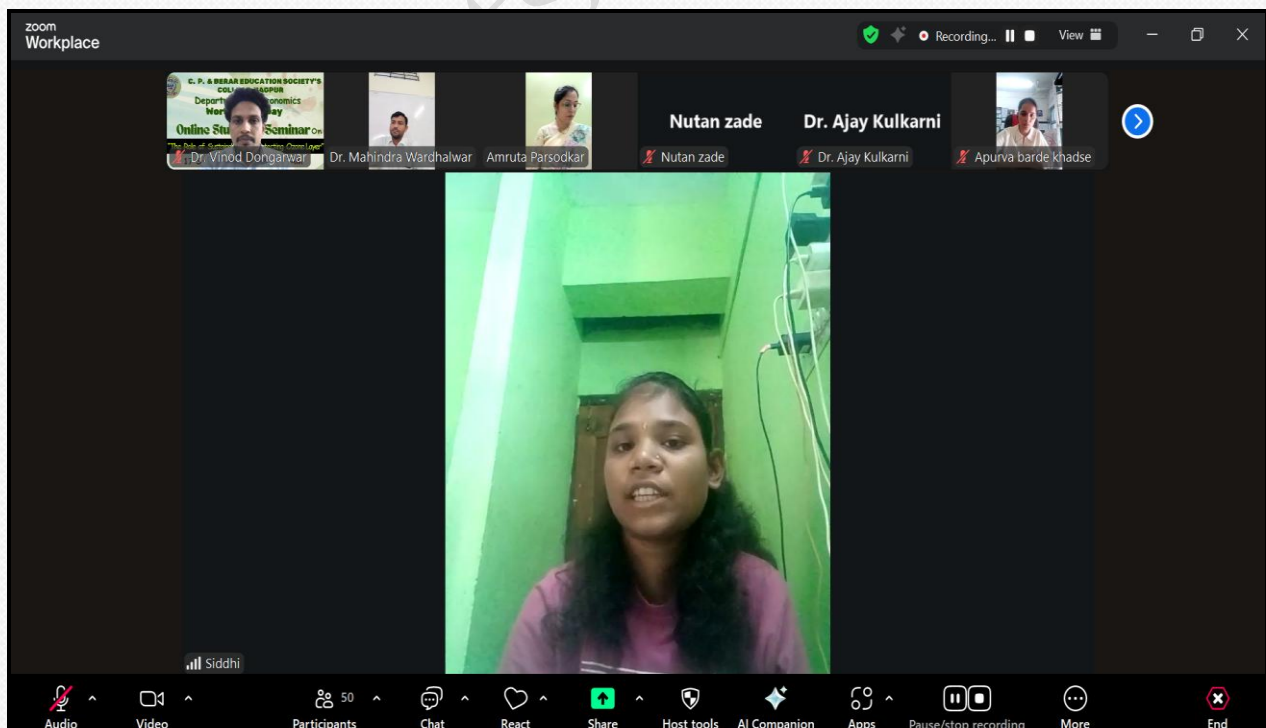

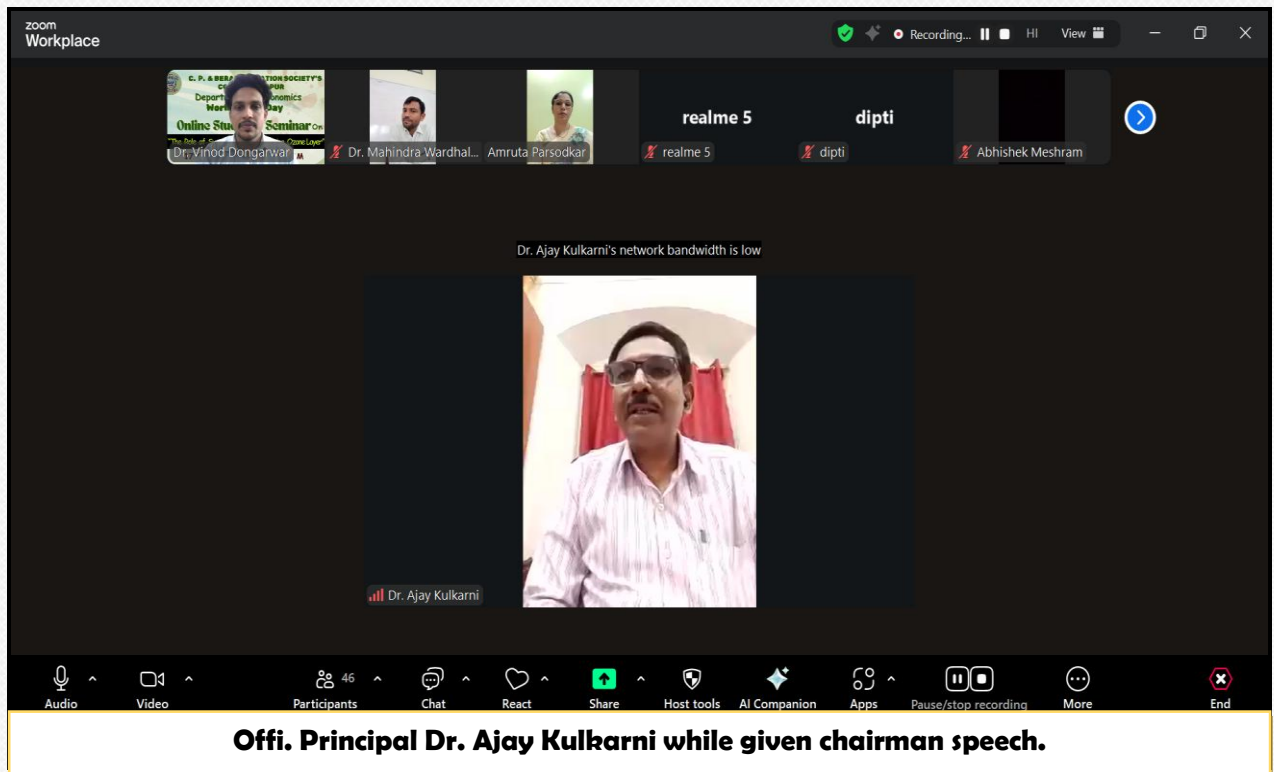

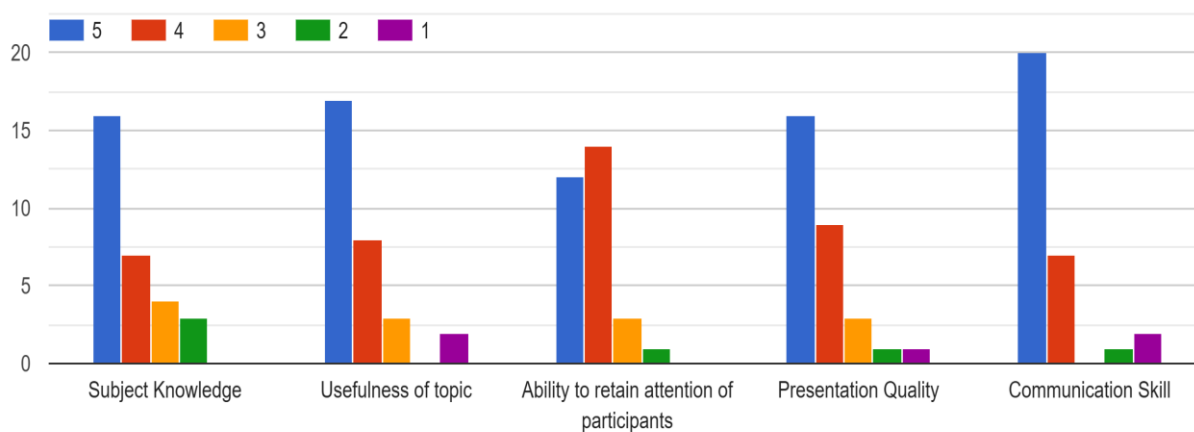

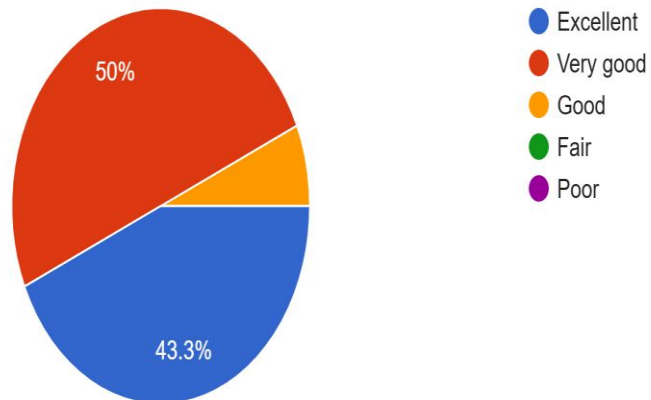


Rate the Resource person Dr. Mahendra Wardhalwar ? (5- Highest to 1- Lowest)



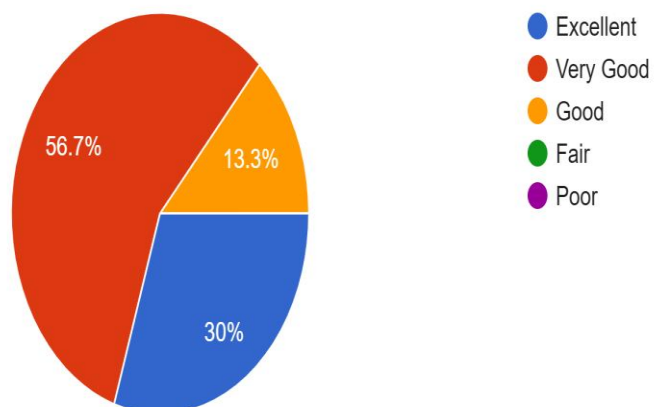
Overall, how you rate the program?
