**Name of Activity: Visit state level - Mahalaxmi
Saras Exhibition-2026**

Brief Report

Introduction:

Field visits and experiential learning constitute an integral part of the higher education curriculum, bridging the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical societal frameworks. On March 14, 2026, the Departments of Economics, Sociology, and Marathi organized a collaborative interdisciplinary educational visit to the prestigious State-level Mahalaxmi Saras Exhibition at Reshimbagh, Nagpur.

The exhibition serves as a vital platform for rural artisans, micro-enterprises, and grassroots collectives to showcase their economic and cultural capital.

Objectives of Activity :

The joint initiative was designed to achieve the following academic and developmental goals:

- **Economic Insights:** To study the practical operations of rural entrepreneurship, pricing strategies, market supply chains, and the financial sustainability of micro-enterprises.
- **Sociological Understanding:** To observe firsthand the structural impact of Women Self-Help Groups (SHGs) on rural community development and gender empowerment.
- **Cultural & Linguistic Appreciation:** To document and engage with regional craftsmanship, diverse cultural heritages, and localized terminologies represented across different geographic zones of the state.

Detailed Description of the Visit :

The student delegation, accompanied by faculty members under the core coordination of Dr. Vinod Dongarwar, reached the exhibition venue at 10:30 AM.

The exhibition featured more than 300 specialized stalls put up by various Women Self-Help Groups (SHGs) and rural entrepreneurs. The students systematically explored the exhibition, dividing their observations into three core components:

A. Rural Entrepreneurship & Micro-Finance (Economics Perspective) -

Students analyzed how small-scale capital is transformed into sustainable livelihoods. They interacted directly with stall owners to understand production costs, packaging challenges, and the role of government subsidies and bank linkages in fostering rural startups. The vast array of agricultural and agro-processed products showcased effective supply-chain management by rural producers.

B. Women's Empowerment & Social Cohesion (Sociology Perspective)

The visit highlighted the transformative role of SHGs in shifting rural women from domestic spheres to active economic agents. Students witnessed how collective bargaining power, financial literacy, and mutual aid networks help marginalized communities break barriers of poverty and social exclusion.

C. Heritage Preservation & Local Craftsmanship (Marathi Perspective)

The exhibition acted as a living archive of regional heritage. Students documented traditional art forms, indigenous textiles, and handcrafted goods. Engaging with artisans from various parts of Maharashtra allowed students to study local dialects, oral traditions tied to craftsmanship, and the cultural narratives embedded in traditional markets.

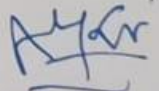

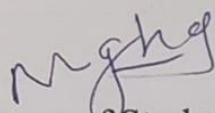

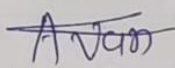
