This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into under the agreement on exchange and collaboration of academic activities on **21st day of July, 2025** between Shri Binzani City College (Autonomous), Nagpur (hereafter called as SBCC) situated in Nagpur, an institution run by Nagpur Shikshan Mandal and C.P. & Berar Education Society's College Mahal, Nagpur (here in after called CPBESC) run by C.P. & Berar Education Society.

Background

SBCC has achieved Autonomous Status from UGC from the academic session 2024-25 onwards. The Department of Economics as a part of the Board of Studies in Social Sciences has designed its syllabi according to the needs of the students.

CPBESC is affiliated to Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur (RTMNU) and follows the syllabi designed by the BoS of RTMNU.

However, both colleges share certain common modules on which both colleges can conduct Student Exchange Programs / Faculty Exchange Programs / Industrial Visits / Interactive Sessions / Field Projects / Research Projects.

7. To share resources, including departmental library and expertise, thereby achieving common academic goals.



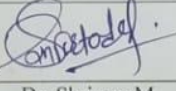
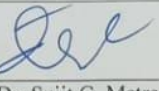
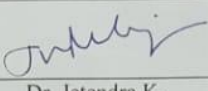
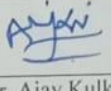
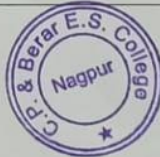
Duration of MOU:

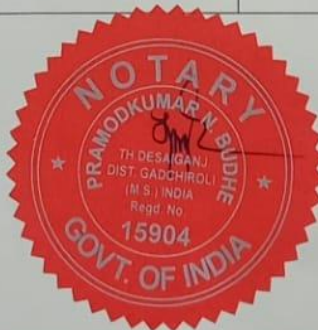
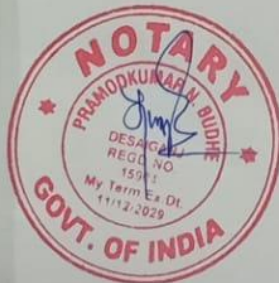
This MOU shall be in effect for a duration of **three years** from the date of signing of the MOU, i.e. **21 /09 / 2028** and automatically extended after the expiration for the same duration, unless written intent of termination by either party is presented three months before the date of expiration.

Funding:

It is specified that sharing of infrastructure and sharing of expertise for academic purposes will not require any commitment of funds. However, for the purpose of industrial visits or any other activity involving external agencies, the expenses should be incurred individually by the colleges. Thus, there will be no financial liability emerging out of this MOU on either of the institutions.

Activity under MoU

1) Bridge Course' in the subject of Economics

Subject: Report on the Organization of a One-Week Bridge Course in the subject of Economics

Collaborating Institutions: Department of Economics, C.P. & Berar Education Society's College, Nagpur, and Department of Economics, Shri Binzani City College, Nagpur.

Duration: 11.08.2025 to 18.08.2025

Introduction & Objective:

Under the auspices of the functional Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the Department of Economics at C. P. & Berar Education Society's College and Shri Binzani City College, Nagpur, a six-day Bridge Course was systematically organized for incoming Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) First-Year students.

The primary pedagogical objective of this intervention was to serve as an academic cushion, orienting and leveling the foundational subject knowledge of a highly diverse student cohort. Recognizing that a significant portion of newly admitted students transition from non-economics streams, the curriculum was curated to demystify core terminologies and provide a comprehensive conceptual overview before the commencement of the standard academic session.

Program Execution & Session Details :

The short-term program spanned 6 to 8 hours of intensive faculty-student interaction. The inaugural session was conducted by Dr. Shriram Fartade, Assistant Professor at Shri Binzani City College, Nagpur, who established the structural framework of the course.

Over the six-day duration, the syllabus meticulously targeted fundamental economic principles, graphical literacy, and baseline methodologies. This targeted approach was specifically designed to:

- Bridge the structural knowledge gap between students with Higher Secondary exposure to Economics and those completely new to the discipline.
- Offer a rigorous revision framework for returning students to fortify their foundational concepts.
- Equip non-traditional students with the requisite academic confidence and psychological assurance to navigate complex curricular challenges in subsequent semesters.



2) Collaborative Lecture Series

Introduction :

To provide students with expert insights, contemporary knowledge, and a broader academic perspective, the Department of Economics at C.P. & Berar E.S. College, Nagpur, hosted a collaborative state-level Online Lecture Series. This academic initiative was organized as a joint venture in partnership with Shri. Binzani City College, Nagpur, and Mahila Kala Mahavidyalaya, Umred. The core vision behind this week-long series was to bridge the gap between abstract theoretical economic models and their practical, real-world applications. By bringing together diverse institutions, the program aimed to foster intellectual growth, encourage interdisciplinary research, and promote professional networking among both faculty and students.

Program Overview

- **Duration:** September 8, 2025, to September 13, 2025 (One Week)
- **Mode:** Online (Virtual Platform via Zoom)
- **Target Beneficiaries:** Undergraduate and Postgraduate Economics Students of all three collaborating institutions.
- **Core Objective:** To enrich students' curriculum understanding, introduce contemporary economic developments, and cultivate research aptitude.

Profile of Esteemed Resource Persons:

The lecture series featured an elite panel of subject matter experts and seasoned academicians who delivered specialized sessions throughout the week:

- Dr. Shriram Fartade, Mr. Upendra Bagul, Dr. Vinod Dongarwar, Mr. Rahul Raut.

Key Themes and Session Proceedings:

Over the course of six days, the lecture series systematically covered a range of vital topics within macroeconomics, Indian economic policies, and research

methodologies.

A. Bridging Theory with Practice :

The speakers successfully decoded complex theoretical paradigms—such as fiscal policies, market structures, and consumer behavioral patterns—and mapped them against current global and national economic trends. This approach allowed students to see how textbook theories directly dictate real-time economic decisions and government policies.

B. Contemporary Economic Developments :

Special emphasis was laid on analyzing post-reform developments in the Indian economy, the socio-economic impacts of digital financial inclusion, and the growing relevance of sustainable and environmental economics in rural and urban landscapes.

C. Promotion of Interdisciplinary Research :

The sessions encouraged students to look beyond traditional economic boundaries. Resource persons highlighted how economics intersects with sociology, data analytics, and entrepreneurial studies, thereby motivating advanced students to undertake empirical research projects.
