Brief Report

In alignment with University Grants Commission (UGC) guidelines and quality enhancement benchmarks set by NAAC, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organized *Deeksharambh – Student Induction Program (SIP)*.

The purpose of the program was to bridge the gap between intermediate schooling/home life and the higher education environment. It was designed to help new entrants adjust to collegiate rigor, understand institutional ethos, familiarize themselves with campus life, and form meaningful intellectual and personal connections with peers and faculty members.

Objectives of Program-

- **Institutional Acculturation:** To introduce students to the vision, mission, legacy, code of conduct, and disciplinary norms of the college.
- **Academic Literacy (NEP-2020):** To demystify the National Education Policy (NEP-2020) curricular structure, credit frameworks, elective options, and evaluation methodologies.

- **Administrative Clarity:** To guide students through essential statutory and university-level processes, including enrollment, examination protocols, and office procedures.
- **Student Support & Equity:** To inform students about state and central government scholarship schemes, fee concessions, and student welfare initiatives.
- **Social & Emotional Integration:** To build camaraderie among students, mitigate transition anxiety, and foster a collaborative mentor-mentee dynamic.

Detailed Proceedings of the Event-

-Inaugural Session & Traditional Lighting of the Lamp:

The induction began with the traditional lighting of the lamp by the dignitaries, invoking wisdom and learning. Present on the dais were Officiating Principal Dr. Ajay Kulkarni, Vice Principal Dr. J. K. Mahajan, IQAC Coordinator Dr. Vinod Dongarwar, and senior faculty members.

-Keynote & Institutional Address:

Dr. Ajay Kulkarni delivered the presidential address, welcoming the freshers. He outlined the institution's historical legacy, infrastructure, library resources, and cultural environment. Dr. Kulkarni also introduced the heads of departments and faculty members across the Arts and Commerce faculties, encouraging students to actively participate in both curricular and co-curricular pursuits.

-Curriculum & Academic Structure (NEP-2020):

Prof. Perna Ratnaparkhi and Dr. Chandrahas Dixit conducted an academic session tailored for the B.A. and B.Com. entrants. They provided an in-depth explanation of the NEP-2020 curriculum, Major/Minor disciplinary pathways,

multidisciplinary courses, continuous internal evaluations (CIE), and end-semester examinations.

-Office Protocols & University Examination Systems:

Shri Ajay Acharya addressed the gathering regarding administrative procedures. He highlighted the step-by-step procedures for university enrollment, registration processes, examination form submissions, identity card distribution, and general administrative services.

-Scholarship Schemes & Financial Welfare Guidance:

Shri Hrushikesh Dube conducted a dedicated orientation on government scholarships, post-matric schemes, minority welfare funds, and merit-based financial aid. He clarified eligibility criteria, online portal navigation, documentation, and deadlines to ensure all eligible students benefit from available welfare schemes.

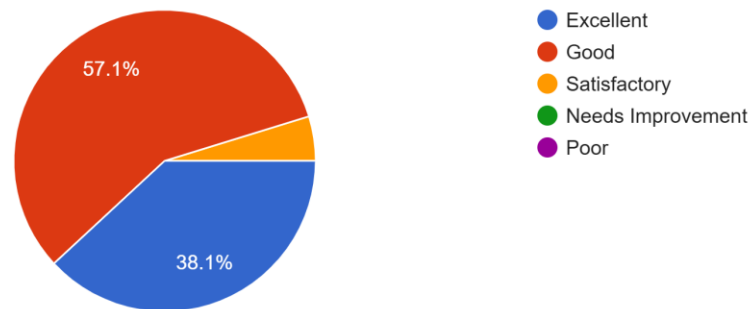

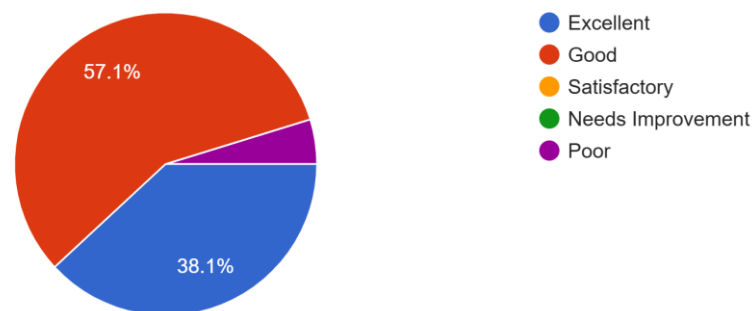

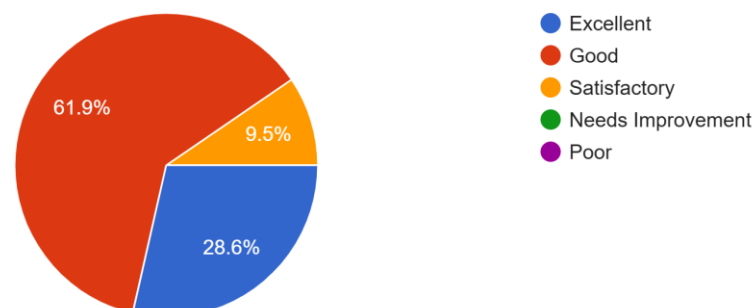

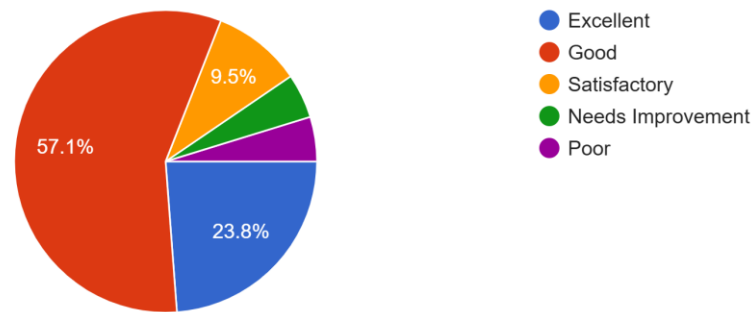

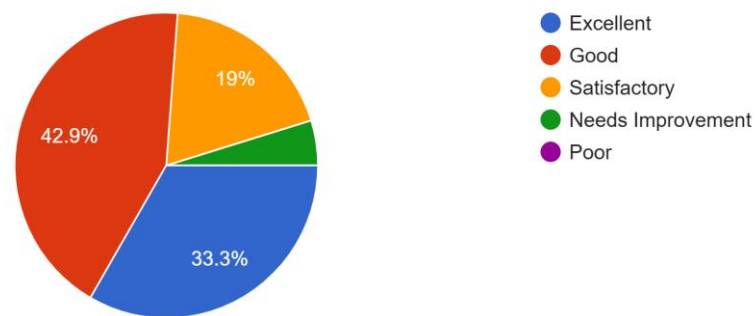
Overview of students Support cells (NSS, NCC etc)

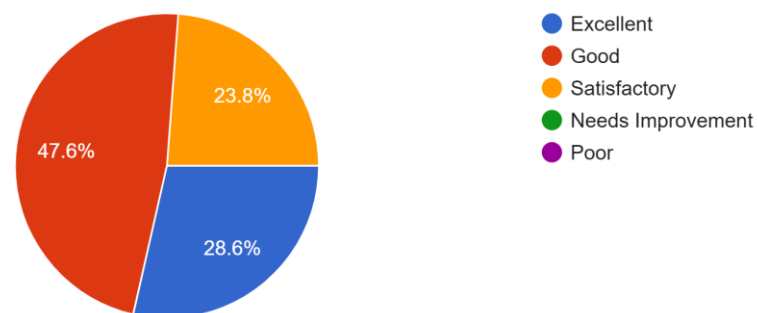

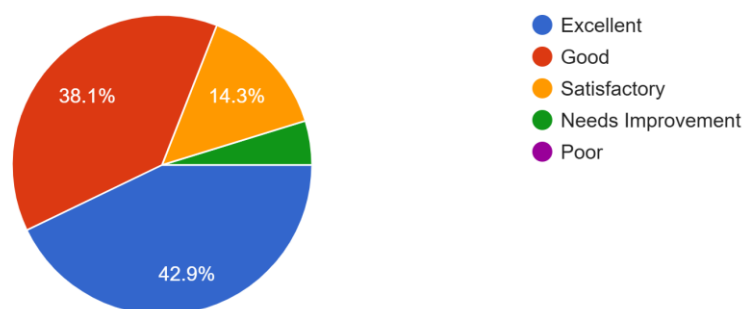
Overall Hospitality seating arrangement, and organization of program.
